

AI Academic Integrity: When do I use AI?

No AI

AI

Permitted

AI must not be used at any stage of this learning or assessment process.

- In some cases, AI may be restricted due to privacy, cultural sensitivity, or age-appropriateness considerations.

Unless a teacher explicitly allows AI use for a specific task, students should assume that AI is not permitted.

Expectations will be clearly communicated to ensure transparency and understanding.

Idea

AI

Starter

With teacher permission, students may use AI for pre-task activities such as planning, brainstorming, outlining and initial research.

- AI is used as a starter with the ideas developed and refined independently.
- AI contributions are limited to idea generation and must not appear in the final product.

Students must disclose their AI use, as directed by the teacher.

Feedback

Helper

Students may use AI to receive feedback during the revision stage, with teacher permission.

- AI can assist with improving clarity, organization, or technical accuracy, but cannot contribute directly to the final product.

Students must disclose their AI use, as directed by the teacher.

Work

AI

Partner

With teacher permission, students may use AI to complete specific aspects of a learning task.

- AI contributions may appear in the final product, provided their **use is transparently disclosed, as directed by the teacher.**
- Students are responsible for assessing any AI-generated content's accuracy, bias, and appropriateness.

Teachers will decide how students will disclose their use of AI. Teachers will also disclose their own use of AI as a model of responsible usage.

Students are responsible for their academic integrity and must remember that AI outputs are never a final product.
